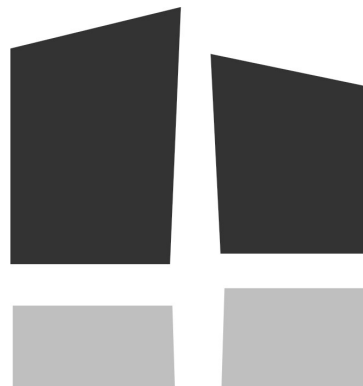

TODAY AND LOOKING AHEAD

Today we begin our Fall sermon series, rooted in the letter by the Apostle Paul to the church in Philippi. We will actually spend more time in Acts 16 this morning, seeing how God worked in remarkable ways to bring this joyful church together.

Next week, we will be looking at Philippians 1:3-11, learning about the importance of partnering in the gospel and praying for each other in Christ.

As we work through Philippians, you are encouraged to read the letter every week. It's only four pages in most Bibles, and just reading the words will help you find the lessons that really stand out. We have also posted a Philippians overview video from the Bible Project on our website, in the "Sermons" section.
