

Please review the following schedule to know when is the best time to come and drop in, or to call one of the staff.

#### **COVID-19 Schedule for Church Office & Staff:**

**Church Office**—open 9:00 am to noon Monday to Friday for calls and drop-ins, keeping in mind physical distancing and limit of 10 people MAX. Staff may also be in the church in the afternoons, but this is completely voluntary. Please call ahead if you want to come by in the afternoon.

**Sundays**—The church is open for bread ministry and those involved in streaming the Sunday morning worship service from 9:00 am to 12:30 pm. Please do not come by unless you are involved in one of these two ministries.

Staff Availability— Pastor Jim works Sunday to Thursday, with Friday as his day off.


Pastor Chris works Tuesday to Friday, and Sunday, with Monday as his day off.
