

## LOOKING AHEAD

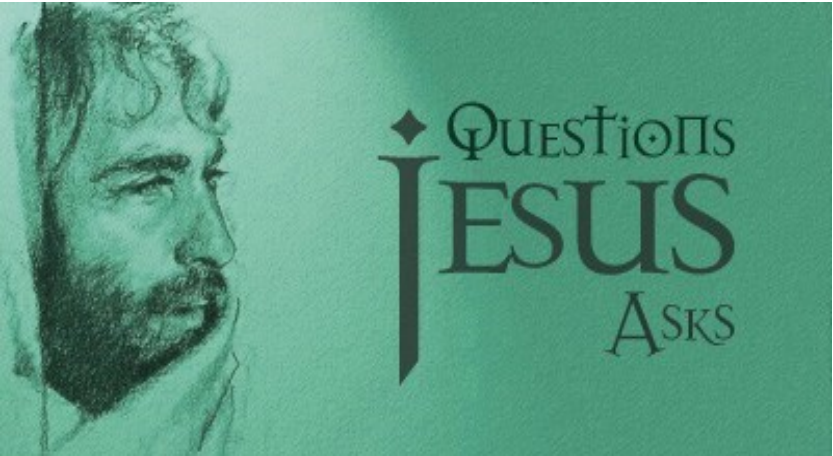
