

UPCOMING SERMONS

Today in church, we will work through chapter seven, asking the question “Who the heck is Melchizedek?” This section of the book as also been humorously referred to as “the chapter that most people skip”. We’re not going to skip it, and hopefully we will ultimately come to appreciate the interplay and relationship between our Jesus and the ancient priest Melchizedek.

Looking ahead to next week, we will cover chapter 8, looking to see how Jesus, as our high priest, just keeps getting better and better. He replaces both the priests that were appointed by the law, and also the covenant that they affirmed.

Each week, you are encouraged to read the Letter to the Hebrews in full, and bring any questions you may have to Pastor Jim. If you do not have a Bible, we can provide you with a paper copy, and/or help you download a Bible app to your smartphone.
