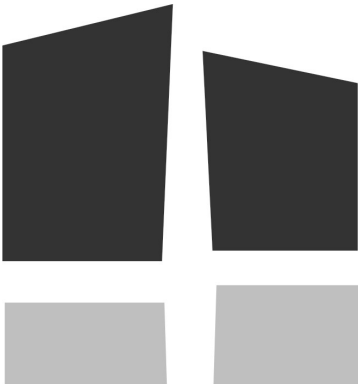

During this time, people may be wondering how to make donations without being able to take a collection. Donations can be made by:

1. Setting up a pre-authorized payment plan through the church's CAFT system. This will set you up with a regular withdrawal from your account. You can indicate the frequency and amount. Please request a form from Peter healpd@sasktel.net.
2. Sending an e-transfers to First Baptist Church at finance@fbcpa.net. Either make up a security question that Bobbi will know the answer to, or use the following question First name of bookkeeper. Answer Bobbi. Make sure to put your name in the personal note and also your address unless we already have it on file. This is a good option for a one time donation.
