

LOOKING AHEAD

Today, we will reading from Philippians 1:12-18, and learning about the importance of making sure that the true gospel of Jesus Christ is shared with those who need to hear it (which, spoiler alert, is all of us!) . We will also apply this passage to the current problem of social media fighting amongst believers.

As we work through the letter to the Philippians, you are encouraged to read the letter every week. It's only four pages in most Bibles, and just reading the words will help you find the lessons that really stand out. We have also posted a Philippians overview video from the Bible Project on our website, in the "Sermons" section.

Next week, we will be working from Philippians 1:19-26, and we will see how Paul longs to go home, but what keeps him planted firmly on Earth.

You are encouraged to read the Letter to the Philippians at least weekly. It is less than four pages in most Bibles. If you would like help with a Bible app for your phone, a reliable Bible website or a physical copy of the Bible, please contact our church office and/or one of our pastors; we will be happy to help.

Nurture Committee Meeting: If you would like to be apart of the Nurture Team please join Tina Stenske on Thursday, October 1st in her home at 7:00 pm.


