In reaction to the new restrictions brought in November 28th, 2020 the Board of Elders, in consultation with the pastoral staff, have made the following decisions:

### Sunday School for all ages will be suspended until the new year. A

Zoom based alternative is being worked on, and if we can have it ready sooner than the new year, we will inform the congregation. Rachel Akers is working on pre-recorded material for children. If you are interested in this, please contact the church office or Rachel directly.

**The Sunday Morning worship service will continue, understanding the maximum number of people in the building must not exceed thirty (30).** Running the service takes between 10-15 people, leaving 15-20 seats for attendees. Those with the capacity and know how to join the service by livestream, on Facebook and YouTube, are strongly encouraged to do so, and leave the physical attendance spots to those who do not have internet connections. If you have the tools to join livestream, i.e. smartphone/tablet/computer and an internet connection, but lack the know how, call the church office and we will be delighted to help you learn how to connect! **Those who want to attend in person must pre-register beforehand, by calling the church office (306-764-5869) before noon on Friday. Again, please consider those without the means to connect via internet, and allow them priority.** We will have an usher at the front door checking off names and counting people. Unfortunately, we will have to turn people away if we reach thirty people in the building. If you have any questions or concerns regarding the above, please call the church office or Pastor Jim's cell at your convenience.
