This morning Pastor Jim will be starting a new sermon series, called “Questions Jesus asked”.

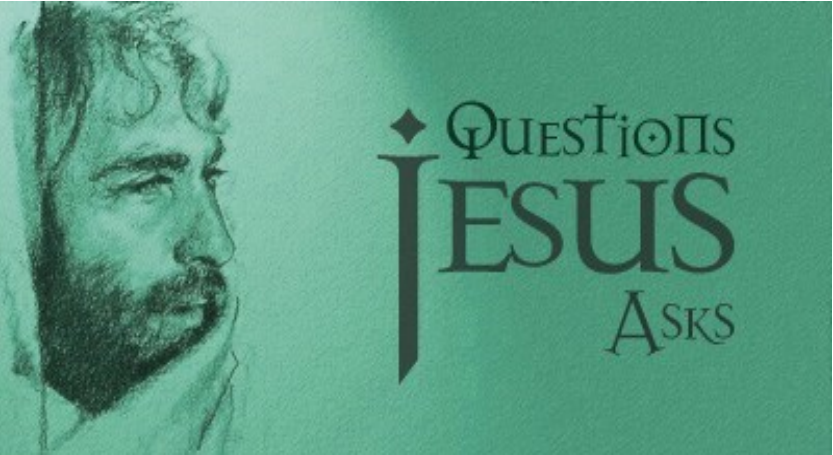
The first question we’ll look at is “Why were you searching for me?”, from Luke 2:41-52.

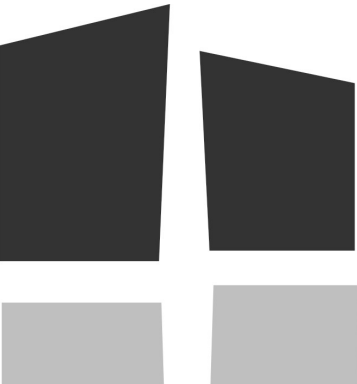
